Scholarship recipients will be chosen by your high school guidance department and/or a selection committee from your school.

NOTE: This form must be submitted in order to be considered for the Mechanics Savings Bank scholarship. Incomplete applications and generic applications (from your high school guidance department) will be disregarded. An application submitted without a phone number and/or address is considered incomplete.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicant must be a high school senior planning to pursue a higher education at a 2- or 4-year college, university or technical school.
- Applicant must have a grade average of 82 or better for 3 years and be in good standing at current high school.
- Applicant must have demonstrated service to school, community, and/or family.
- Applicant must be of a good moral character.

2. Transcripts from 3 years and first semester of senior year.
